Location:

Banjo Paterson Park, Kosciusko Road, Lake Jindabyne

Trophies & Prizes

A Perpetual Trophy will be given to the winning Teams.

Distance

Saturday 2000m turn race (1st, 2nd and 3rd place only /winner will be based on the fastest time)

Sunday 200 metres (sprints) – 2 heats + final per category (depending upon numbers)

Entry fees:

DBNSW Inc / CDBA Club crews:

Saturday - \$10 pp (adults) and \$5 pp Junior (distance)

Sunday - \$20 pp (adults) and \$10 pp (juniors) which covers more than one category i.e. mixed and women

Note: All fees are inclusive of GST.

All paddlers in the team must pay entry fee including drummer and sweep.

Team Composition – as per the category definitions and race rules;

All teams must have a minimum of 16 paddlers to a maximum of 20 paddlers, 4 reserves, 1 drummer, 1 sweep;

Sports Mixed Crews:

Maximum of 50% male paddlers (excludes drummer and sweep)

Sports Women's Crews:

All female paddlers (must have a female drummer & sweep);

Sports Men's Crews: (TBC depending on number of entries)

Must have 20 Male paddlers in the crew (drummer/sweep can be either gender)

Junior Mixed Crews:

Maximum of 50% male paddlers (drummer and sweep can be either gender). Paddlers and drummer must be aged between 12-17 years. Sweep can be over 18 years.

Masters Crews: All paddlers must be over 40 years (as of 01st June). **Please indicate on entry form. (Note: sports and masters will be raced together in the heats)**

Note:

Every team must use a DBNSW/CDBA Accredited sweeps. All sweeps must get their names ticked off by the Chief Marshall. Level 2 sweeps must wear the orange safety vests (which can be collected/returned to marshalling). Clubs must provide their own Sweeps. (If for some reason a club can't provide their own Sweep they can borrow a level 2 sweep from another club).

If entering more than one team in the same category (up to 4 paddlers can be interchanged between crews). They must be the same 4 paddlers which includes drummer/sweep.

Compulsory for all Team Members to wear current membership cards.

- Padding or gripping material is not permitted (wax is permitted).
- all teams are to use a DBNSW accredited sweep. Sweeps will be provided upon request to the organisers prior to the event only.
- every member of the paddling team must be able to swim 50 metres or otherwise wear a buoyancy vest,
- any protests must be lodged in writing and accompanied by \$200 cash protest fee within 15 minutes of completion of the protested race. The protest fee is only refundable if the protest is successful.

| Category Criteria: | All teams comprise a minimum 16 paddlers (plus drummer and sweep) to a maximum of 26 paddlers (including drummer and sweep) As per DBNSW Bye-Laws (available on the DBNSW website) |
| Team Composition | As per DBNSW definitions on the front page |
| Qualifying for Finals | Points are allocated on placings in heat results and added together to form finals qualifications. If more than 6 teams qualify, the times of teams on equal points will be added to identify the 4-6 fastest qualifying teams. |
| Rules of Racing | AusDBF Race rules and Regulations with NSW local Bye-laws |
| Safety: | Sweeps are responsible for crew safety and must be familiar with DBNSW Inc safety guidelines (refer DBNSW website). Weak or non-swimmers MUST wear a life vest. |
| Sweeps: | Only AusDBF accredited sweeps. 'L2 sweeps' must wear orange vests. All sweeps must have their names recorded with the marshall for every race |
| First Aid: | St Johns Ambulance personal will be on duty (SES) |
| Prizes: | Trophies will be awarded to all category winners, second and third as well depending upon number of entries. |
| Uniforms: | All teams must wear a distinguishable uniform (e.g. caps, t-shirts etc) |
| Clean-up: | All teams are requested to clean up their area at the end of the day. |
| Security: | Teams are responsible for the security of their valuables. BE WARY. |
