



2010 Lake Jindabyne Dragon Boat Challenge

Dragon Boat NSW Inc.(DBNSW)

Distance

200 metre sprints

Heats/ Finals

2 heats for each team + final per category (depending upon Category number))

Entry fees: \$500 per team (if entering one team only)

OR \$25 pp if entering more than one category i.e. mixed and women

DBNSW Inc / CDBA Club crews:

Note: All fees are inclusive of GST. All paddlers in the team must pay entry fee including drummer and sweep.

Team Composition – as per the category definitions and race rules;

All teams must have a minimum of 16 paddlers , 1 drummer and 1 sweep to a maximum of 20 paddlers, 4 reserves, 1 drummer, 1 sweep;

Premier Mixed Crews

Maximum of 10 males paddlers (excludes drummer and sweep);

Premier Women's Crews

All female paddlers (must have a female drummer & sweep);

Premier Open Crews

Any gender.

Masters Mixed Crews

Maximum of 10 males paddlers (excludes drummer and sweep). All paddlers must be over 40 years (as of 01st June) drummer and sweep can be younger (min 12 years).

Masters Women Crews

All female paddlers. All paddlers must be over 40 years (as of 01st June) drummer and sweep can be younger. (min 12 years).

Junior - Mixed Crew (12 - 17 years)

Every team must use a DBNSW Accredited sweeps. "p" sweeps must wear orange vests. All sweeps must get their names ticked off by the Chief Marshall. Compulsory for all Team Members to wear current 09/10 membership cards.

Note: teams with 2 teams in the same category, must collect coloured wrist bands from Registration for each team to wear, to make it easier for quick identification. Teams can have up to 4 paddlers interchange between the 2 teams (i.e 2 mixed teams).

- reimburse the event organisers for any damages or losses caused by the entrant to equipment provided by the event organisers,
- utilise only equipment and fittings provided or required by the event organisers. **(Paddles will be supplied if teams do not have own)**
- Padding or gripping material is not permitted (wax is permitted).
- all teams are to use a DBNSW accredited sweep. Sweeps will be provided upon request to the organisers prior to the event only.
- every member of the paddling team must be able to swim 50 metres or otherwise wear a buoyancy vest,
- any protests must be lodged in writing and accompanied by \$200 cash protest fee within 15 minutes of completion of the protested race. The protest fee is only refundable if the protest is successful.
- I certify that each member of the team understands and undertakes to be bound by the conditions of entry,

Times:	8am – 4pm – Sunday Races
Captain Briefing	Sun – 8am – at the finish line
Location:	Banjo Paterson Park Jindabyne
2009/2010 Membership cards	Membership photo ID Tags are issued upon membership payment to DBNSW/CDBA and will be required at each DBNSW event.
Race Schedule:	Will be distributed on Wednesday 10 February via email
Race Distances:	200 metres
Boats:	4 -6 x fibreglass (depending upon no's of entries).
Paddles:	Only IDBF spec paddles (202a) will be accepted
Categories:	Premier open; Premier women's; Premier Mixed; Masters women's; Masters Mixed; Junior- Mixed;
Category Criteria:	All teams comprise a minimum 16 paddlers (plus drummer and sweep) to a maximum of 26 paddlers (including drummer and sweep) As per standard DBNSW definitions (available on the DBNSW website)
Team Composition	As per standard DBNSW definitions (available on the DBNSW website)
Qualifying for Finals	Points are allocated on placings in heat results and added together to form finals qualifications. If more than 6 teams qualify, the times of teams on equal points will be added to identify the 4-6 fastest qualifying teams..
Rules of Racing	Standard DBNSW Rules of Racing . And will defer to AusDBF as required.
Safety:	Sweeps are responsible for crew safety and must be familiar with DBNSW Inc safety guidelines (attached). Weak or non-swimmers MUST wear a life vest.
Sweeps:	Only DBNSW accredited sweeps. 'P' Platers must wear orange vests. All sweeps must have their names recorded with the marshall for every race
First Aid:	St Johns Ambulance personal will be on duty (SES)
Prizes:	Medal's will be awarded to all category winners, second and third as well depending upon number of entries.
Uniforms:	All teams must wear a distinguishable uniform (e.g. caps, t-shirts etc)
Clean-up:	All teams are requested to clean up their area at the end of the day.
Security:	Teams are responsible for the security of their valuables. BE WARY.
